



Imagine having to live in someone else's home indefinitely because you don't have your own. How would you feel? This is exactly what Malini's family had to go through until SOS Family Strengthening Program field officers found them. Malini's family completes five years in the programme at the end of 2019, and now they are living in their own house peacefully.

Malini has four children. Two are in their teens, 18 and 14 years old, and the other two are below 10 years of age. Her husband is a woodcraftsman and alcoholic: this addiction has diminished his ability to contribute to the welfare of the family. She is S0 SOS for grateful to supporting her family via the FSP programme that has enabled them to save money and build a house of their own. All educational expenses of three of her children have been covered by the FSP programme for

the past four years and the current fifth and final year will be covered as well. It is this major saving that has helped them build the house.

Malini's elder daughter is quite talented and showed us a handful of medals which she has won in athletics. She is auite studious as well. Such families as Malini's are able to reach better standards of living because of the benefits provided by the FSP programme by SOS Children's Sri Villages, Lanka. If not for this programme, Malini's family would have had continue living in outsiders homes helplessly.
